



## Installing Your Site

**REQUIREMENTS** To install your site you will need a domain name and web hosting.

If you do not have either I would suggest buying a domain name from <http://godaddy.com> and the hosting offered by <http://hostgator.com>


you can install the site on a main domain, a subdomain or a subfolder of a domain.

However I recommend buying a domain name specifically for your site.

## INSTALLING

To install your new site you will need to install a default WordPress installation. Your hosting control panel (cPanel) should have an automated WordPress installer included. It will be found in the “Software and services” section. There are various installers i.e. QuickInstall, Fantastico or Softaculous.

## EXAMPLE




Your particular installer will depend on your specific host. If your host does not include an automated installer then you should seriously consider changing your host.

However as a last resort you can install a clean version of WordPress manually using the instructions at the link below.

Once you have installed your website login to your wordpress admin. Go to plugins – add new – and type in All-in-One WP Migration



Install and activate the plugin All in one WP migration

The next step is to upload an extension to the plugin.

This can be found in the website folder you downloaded and is the zip file


all-in-one-wp-migration-unlimited-extension – **upload this and activate**

In some cases depending on your hosting they limit the maxfile size you can upload this extension breaks everything down to overcome this problem

You can now go ahead and install the site using the All in one Migration plugin simply follow the details below.

**Please note: Importing a file may take some time so please be patient before you use the troubleshooting section.**

Click on the plugin in your dashboard select import and choose file.



Open the folder containing your site purchase and you will see a folder named Website

Inside this will be a file named .....

instantnichebiz.com-bitcoin-20210319-143409-d91qyn.wordpress

Click on this file to import your new site. **If your site is not uploading please see the trouble shooting section below**

**Once your site has installed your login details will have changed. You can find the details in your website file folder you downloaded Your new site should now be installed.**

#### IMPORTANT SECURITY MEASURE

The next step is to change your password. The current password is generic and will be known by all site owners so you need to immediately change it for security.

Go to Users/Your Profile and update your profile with your own details i.e. name and email address.

Scroll down to the bottom and Generate a new password and Update Profile.


Ensure you have copied your password to a safe place before saving.

Log out and log back in with your new password to ensure all is working OK

CHANGE SITE NAME & ADMIN EMAIL From Settings/General change the site name to suit your new domain and change the Admin Email to your own.

Everything should now be working fine.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**



**Although the Internet Connection is good, and it's a fairly new WordPress Installation without any installed plugins, the import might be stuck at 0% or 100% or any other number, and it's a common problem with the plugin.**

**I am not sure why the plugin developers didn't address/fix it until now, but here's how to solve it using the back up method**

**Login to FTP or use Cpanel**


**Use [FileZilla](#) or any other File Transfer Protocol Software or even your Cpanel to access the Hosting Files of your Wordpress Website.**

**Upload your .wpres file to the "backup" directory**


**Go to the "backup" directory of the All-in-One WP Migration Plugin;  
wp-content/ai1wm-backups/**

Using either a FTP client or your cpanel Upload your .wpress file found in your download folder named instantnichebiz.com-bitcoin-20210319-143409-d91qyn.wpress (or similar) to the ailwm-backups folder.


From your wordpress dashboard click on All in one wp migration – choose back up then restore



After a while, you will get this lifesaver popup... Click on “Proceed” to continue:



A few seconds/minutes later, everything is done! Follow the steps in the notice
